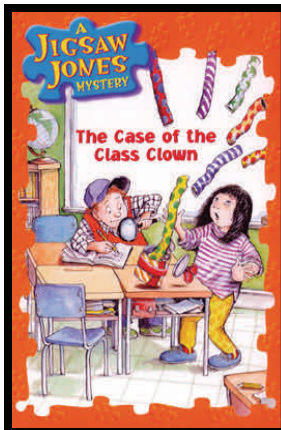
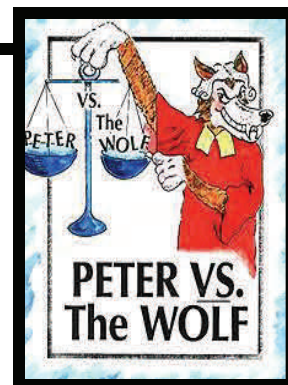
Peter vs. the Wolf—Oct. 14, 2011.

Based on the book by renowned author James Preller, this show is sure to make students laugh and think as they learn the secret codes that Jigsaw must decipher to solve the mystery.

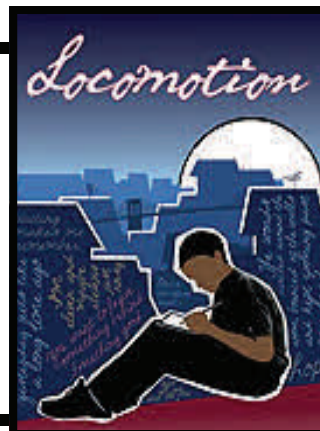
