Literacy and GED Preparation

Small group and individualized study sessions provide adult students, 18 years of age or older, an opportunity to improve basic reading, writing, and/or math skills leading to a GED. Our computer labs also offer the opportunity to improve these skills. Classes are available mornings afternoons, and evenings.

We now offer GED On-Line to qualified students.



Family Literacy

This program is designed to break the cycle of illiteracy within families. We teach parents reading, math, language, and computer in preparation for a GED. We also help foreign born students. Parenting classes and childcare are also

available.



E.S.O.L.

Our ESOL program provides class instruction to speakers of other languages so that they may acquire

the life skills necessary to function successfully in our society. Students receive instruction in speaking, reading, listening, and understanding English. In addition, they are taught critical thinking, decision making, goal setting, and self-esteem.

We also have ESOL in North Port and at the Cultural Center.



Adult Transition

The program provides such services as self-care, recreation, cooking, daily living skills, basic knowledge, social skills, and communication for adults 18 and over with physical and mental disabilities. The in-

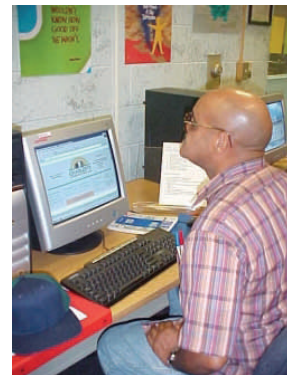
struction helps students improve skills that will enable them to be productive members of our community.
