Over 2.1 million lunches and more than 700,000 breakfasts were served to students in the 2010/2011 school year. 61% of the students in our district's 20 schools were eligible for free or reduced-price meals in 2010/2011. Champ's Café Restaurants consistently receive superior ratings on quarterly Health Department Inspections, the state's School Meals Initiative Audit and Comprehensive Review Audits. All Champ's Café Managers are state-certified professional food managers knowledgeable in the HACCP (Hazard Analysis of Critical Control Points) program for sanitation.

Guidelines

Champ's Café is a state and federally funded program regulated by U.S. Department of Agriculture. Free & Reduced-Price Meal Benefits

A new family application is required each school year. Families may submit another application *at any time* during the school year when income or the number of household members changes. Turn the completed application in to your child's school office. The district has up to 10 days to process the application. *Please send money for meals in the meantime!* USDA requires that families pay for their child's meals until free or reduced-price meal benefits are approved.

To apply for meal benefits online, log onto champs.yourcharlotteschools.net, or print a **Meal Benefits Application from the Charlotte County Public Schools website:** www.yourcharlotteschools.net

To maintain privacy, all students enter their personal keypad number at the cash register. All students then state their last name to verify their personal account. Payments for meals are to be made in advance or at the time of meal service. If a customer does not have money for their meal, they should ask to see the Manager. **Courtesy meals are to be paid back the very next school day.** *Create a "safety net" for your child by keeping enough money in their account so they can depend on eating a healthy meal at school every day!*

The Champ's Café budget pays for all salaries and benefits of its staff, cost of energy and utilities, equipment replacement, food and supplies from its revenues.

When making pre-payments for more than one student account in the same school, please indicate the amount to be deposited in each student's account. Please make your check payable to **Champ's Café**, noting both keypad numbers and first and last student names on the check.

Management System). There is a per student transaction fee of **\$1.95** associated with online credit/debit card payments; no annual subscription fee.

The School Food and Nutrition Services Department supports the district vision of **"Student Success!"** by providing nutritious, high quality food choices that are attractive, reasonably-priced and served in a safe, sanitary and customer-friendly environment.



ENTREES or Champ's Main Dish Items:

Elementary school customers may select the featured entrée or chef salad, turkey deli sandwich, or Champ "Smile" Pack of turkey, cheese and crackers. Middle school customers may select the featured entrée or a chef salad, pizza, deli sandwich, hamburger, or chicken fillet sandwich. High school Food Courts serve customers more than 20 choices daily including salads, sub & wrap sandwiches, hamburgers, pizza, chicken specialty sandwiches, chicken nuggets, Mexican, Italian & Asian entrees, and a rotating "just like home" meal at the Main Event line. Milk & juice, fruits and vegetables, Champ's fresh-baked rolls, buns and muffins complete each meal. **Special Diet Needs:** Along with the individual student, his/her parents, physician and school nurse, the Champ's Cafe staff is part of the Health Care Plan Team who works together to accommodate food allergies, food intolerances, diabetes, and other conditions affecting one's diet. **Vegetarian and Religious** preferences are honored by contacting the Manager at your child's school.

Menus are planned to meet the USDA (United States Department of Agriculture) Dietary Guidelines while offering our customers their favorite nutritious foods. Please see the published menu on the district website for day-to-day menu offerings (*under District, choose Departments and then Food Service*). Nutrition information can be found online and posted at each **Champ's Café**.

Breakfast is offered every day at all schools 30 minutes before the school day begins. Customers may select a breakfast such as fortified cereal and muffin, ham and cheese bagel sandwich, scrambled eggs and sausage, French toast sticks, or a fresh-baked whole wheat cinnamon roll along with milk and juice. Freshly-made oatmeal is offered free as part of school breakfast every day at every **Champ's Cafe**.

Lunch A "School Lunch" includes an entree, bread, fruit, two servings of vegetables and lowfat milk. Extras or ala carte items, such as a carton of milk or bottle of water, can be purchased at the cash register.
